Government Funding for Software & Hardware Implementation



Canadian Agricultural Partnership

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be in agriculture, food or beverage business
- Cannabis sector is now eligible
- Must be located anywhere in Canada
- Intake Deadlines vary by province or territory

Eligible Cost

- Software and Hardware
- Advisory and Consulting
- Implementation, one-time setup fee
- Training in hardware and software use
- Labour cost



Amount: 35% of the project cost up to \$100,000



Ontario Automotive Modernization Program

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be an automotive parts manufacturer located in Ontario
- Must be adopting Hardware or Software to improve productivity and increase competitiveness (e.g. ERP systems)
- Next intake: [Expected in Spring 2021](#)

Eligible Cost

- Software and Hardware
- Advisory and Consulting
- Implementation, one-time setup
- Training in hardware and software use
- Labour cost for employees involved in implementation project



Amount: 50% of the cost up to a maximum of \$100,000



SME In Action Program

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a manufacturing or technology company
- Must be located in Quebec

Eligible Cost

- Software cost
- Implementation cost
- Labour cost



Amount: 40% of the project cost up to \$50,000



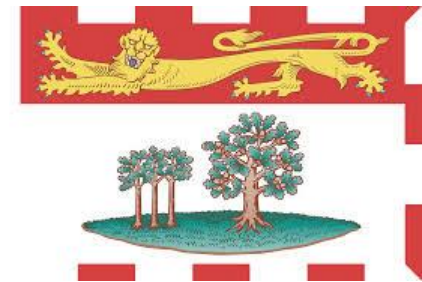
IT Implementation Assistance

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a small-to-medium-sized enterprise
- Must be located in Prince Edward Island
- Must have a well-developed export-oriented business and marketing plans

Eligible Cost

- Hardware and software acquisition
- Computer, network and peripheral equipment
- Commercial off-the-shelf or custom software
- Commerce / e-business solutions development
- Project management and systems integration services



Amount: 40% of the project cost up to \$40,000



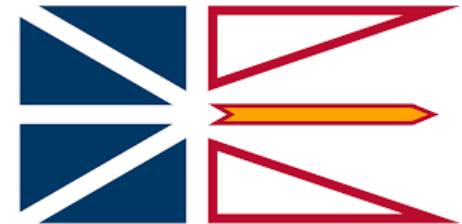
Business Development Support Program

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be a small-to-medium-sized enterprise & employ fewer than 100 employees
- Must be located in Newfoundland & Labrador

Eligible Cost

- Hardware and software acquisition
- Implementation
- Consulting
- Project management and systems integration
- Labour cost



Amount: 75% of the project cost up to \$100,000



Government Funding for Skills Training



Canada Job Grant

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be for-profit business of any size anywhere in Canada with at least one payroll employee
- Current employee or Candidate must complete the training in order to fill the vacancy OR
- Current employee must complete the training to improve existing skills or obtain new skills resulting in trainee's salary raise, promotion or both
- Current employee or Candidate must be Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or protected person (refugee)
- Training completion must be substantiated by a completion certificate or diploma
- Deadline: **March 31, 2021**

Eligible Cost

- Training (tuition) fees paid to third parties



Amount: \$10,000 - \$15,000 per trainee (50% to 100% of the training cost)



Yves Landry Foundation's AIME

Eligibility Criteria

- Must have 10 - 1000 employees
- Must be in business for at least 3 years and be able to demonstrate strong financial performance
- Must be a manufacturer located in Southern Ontario
- **Limited Intake is Open. Act Now!**

Eligible Cost

- Training (tuition) fees paid to third parties
- Books & training supplies/materials
- Travel & accommodation
- Trainees' and trainers' salaries (if the training is internal)

Amount: 25%-50% of the project cost up to \$100,000





Purposes of Funding

- Equipment Purchasing, Productivity Improvement
- Skills Training
- Hiring
- Export Business Development
- Software Implementation & Training
- Research & Development
- Business Expansion, e.g. Plant Construction

- **Software / Hardware project cost may be part of expansion budget!**

- **The Government Provides No Operational Funding!**
